St. Richard's Festival started in 2007 and has grown rapidly through the addition of street markets, new attractions and the Classic and Vintage Car Rally. The event fills the streets in Droitwich Spa town centre and Vines Park and provides visitors with a great day out in the heart of this historic salt town.

The festival celebrates the life of St Richard, the Spa's patron saint, who – legend has it – made the town's brine wells flow again in the Middle Ages. It offers attractions to suit all ages ranging from medieval re-enactment and entertainment to classic and vintage cars and boat trips on the Droitwich Canal.

This year's event will be joined by a boating festival in Vines Park, which means for the first time it will run over 3 days offering even more attractions.




